Quick Overview of Changes - Spring 2010

1. A new "game roster" can be used for *each* WyoLeague game.
2. Bond checks are no longer required. In the event of non-performance by a club's teams, the club will be billed the non-performance fees.
3. Every league team that played in Fall 2009 **MUST** include a copy of its last official roster with the team registration form – whether there are changes to the team or not.
 - a. Cross out on that roster any players and/or coaches who are not returning or will be transferred to another team.
4. The "Request to Postpone a Scheduled Game" form **MUST** be used if requesting a postponement due to field closures, not enough refs, or for a team that has approval to travel to an out of state tournament. **NO** other requests for schedule changes will be accepted or considered.
5. Please be sure and submit the field info and ref assignor form. If the league administrator does not have that form they can choose to not schedule a club's teams.
6. Please be sure your coaches and team managers know that they will have the opportunity to review and request changes to the **DRAFT** game schedule. Once the **FINAL** schedule is posted, unless something truly unexpected happens, the schedule can not be changed.
7. Watch for another email regarding the new rules for submission of player and team personnel registration data. Since I no longer have the online registration system one of the most difficult things will be tracking who is added to a team, moved to another team, or removed completely. The new rules will address that issue in particular.
