**VOTING PROCEDURE:** A WYS affiliated club, in good standing, may send a delegate (or delegates) to each WYS board meeting. The delegate is authorized to cast votes that are equal to the number of votes the delegate's club is allowed.

In accordance with the WYS bylaws each executive board member (president, vice president, secretary, treasurer), except the board president, unless there is a tie vote, each appointed administrator (6), and the WYS DOC each have one vote.

**PROXY:** An affiliated club having votes at a WYS board meeting may have its votes cast by proxy. It is recommended but not required that the Proxy Voting form be used. The proxy must be in writing, dated and signed by the club president, specifying the date the proxy is effective. The proxy can be emailed, faxed or given to the WYS office manager or other non-voting member before roll is taken at the specified meeting. To be eligible to vote each executive officer, appointed administrator, and the state DOC must be present as a proxy vote will not be accepted for those members.
