Voting members shall consist of designated delegates or their proxies from properly constituted and affiliated youth soccer clubs in good standing with the Association. A Voting Member's voting strength shall be based on player numbers as of July 31 of the prior year's registration total, per State Registrar records, with a maximum of 6 (six) votes per voting member. Voting strength will be distributed as follows:

1 to 500 players 2 (two) votes	501 to 1000 players 3 (three) votes
1001 to 1500 players 4 (four) votes	1501 to 2000 players 5 (five) votes
	2001 or more players 6 (six) votes

VOTING PROCEDURE: A WYS affiliated club, in good standing, may have delegates at each WYS board meeting equal to the number of votes it is allowed to cast at the meeting and an alternate to each delegate. All votes of the club may be cast by any of the delegates present at the time of the vote even if not all of its representatives are present. In accordance with the WYS bylaws each executive officer, except the board president, each appointed administrator, and the state DOC have one vote each.

PROXY: An affiliated club having a vote at a WYS board meeting may have its vote cast by proxy. The proxy must be in writing, dated and signed by the club president, specifying the date for which the proxy is effective. The proxy must be presented to the WYS board secretary before a vote can be cast. To be eligible to vote each executive officer, each appointed administrator, and the state DOC must be present as a proxy vote will not be accepted for those board members.
